# Lead, Learn and Link for All – 3L4All

Training course, Key Action 1: Mobility project for young people and youth workers

From June 16th to 24<sup>th</sup>

Saint Yzans de Médoc, Gironde

### BACKGROUND OF THE PROJECT

Concordia was created after the WW2 in order to rebuild what was destroyed during the war and to promote peace between people. Concordia joined the movement of non-formal education. We are promoting an education for all by all without age, sexual, cultural, religious or economic distinction. Beyond all, on his charter, Concordia encourages the circulation of people and ideas through international exchanges.

This historic activity of Concordia is to organize international workcamps. Each summer, we are now organizing around 100 workcamps in France. Through this European training, Concordia would like to provide a practical training, to give concrete tools to the workcamps 'leaders and other youth projects. The exchanges will be even more interesting between field workers coming from different country who have different work practices that we could talk about during the training and that other participants could apply. It's also a wish to professionalize their workers and to looking for innovative initiatives in animation needs and pedagogy. During this training, a special focus will be done on the **inclusion of participants with fewer opportunities** in our international projects.

### Objectives of the project:

Offer to the youth worker involved in an organization a training at the end of which they will be able to lead youth actions (training, work camps, youth exchange) in an European context and with a focus on the inclusion of young people with fewer opportunities.

#### Specific objectives:

- Analyze and understand the different topics and issues in the field of youth trainings;
- Share experience, knowledge and working methods in order to improve the quality of the training for workcamp leaders, notably regarding the issue of the inclusion of participants with fewer opportunities (social, economic, geographic difficulties...);
- Promote intercultural learning and cultural diversity;
- Encourage active citizenship and youth participation through an inclusive and participatory approach;
- Stimulate co-operation among youth organizations.

## Activities

We will offer several activities to get participants to think about:

- What being a leader of an intercultural project means?
- How to make sure that each participant gets involved in the project?
- How to manage a conflict in a group?
- What does it mean to host a young person with fewer opportunity in the group? Is it really different?

In order to address these issues, we will use debates, forum theatre, work in small and bigger group, experience sharing...

## Methodology

The methodology, based on the reinforcement of non-formal education values and the structure of this European training will serve to further encourage an active involvement of each participant. This will allow participants to be able to develop competencies and new tools in order to develop a sensitive approach about intercultural issues in their organization and spread the final outcomes.

Non-formal education values will be share with workshops in large or small groups, sharing of experience and know-how, debates, participative evaluations - using innovating methods of learning.

## PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

This training targets social workers, youth workers, volunteers, work camps leaders, active members in their organization curious about youth projects and **young people with fewer opportunitie's inclusion**.

Participants need to be motivated and ready to participate to the entire training. The idea is also that the participants lead a youth project (youth exchange, work camp...) after the training.

## FINANCIAL ASPECTS

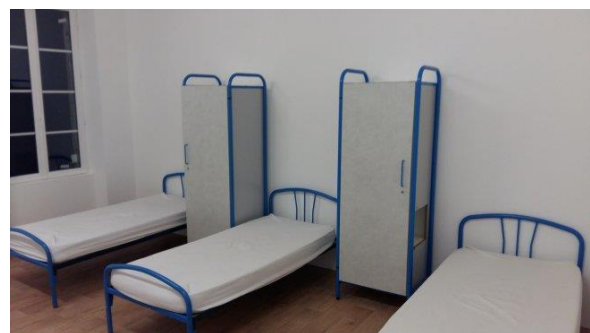
