



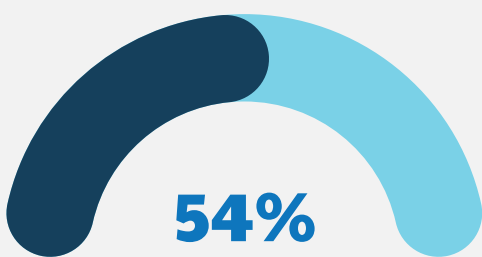
NEWSLETTER DATA INFOGRAPHIC

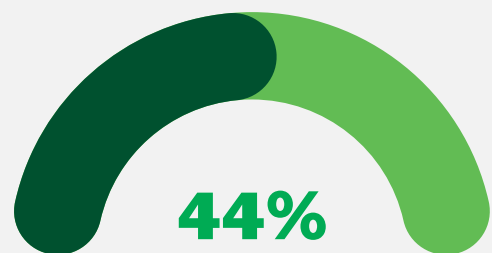
**TOTAL NUMBER OF

(on average)**

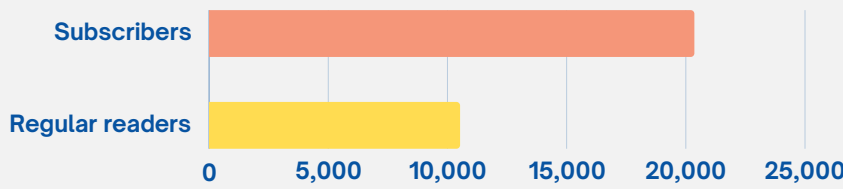

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES**

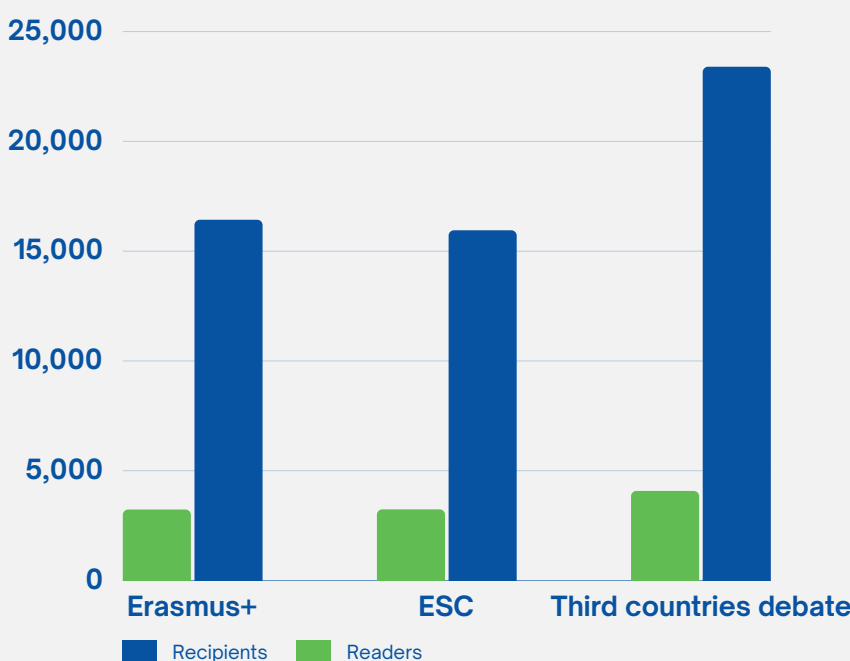

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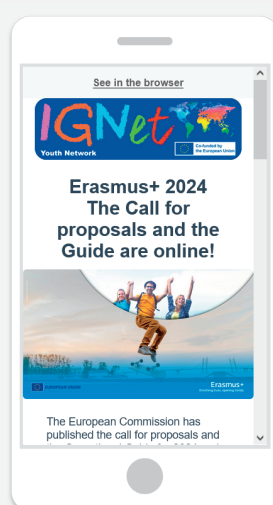
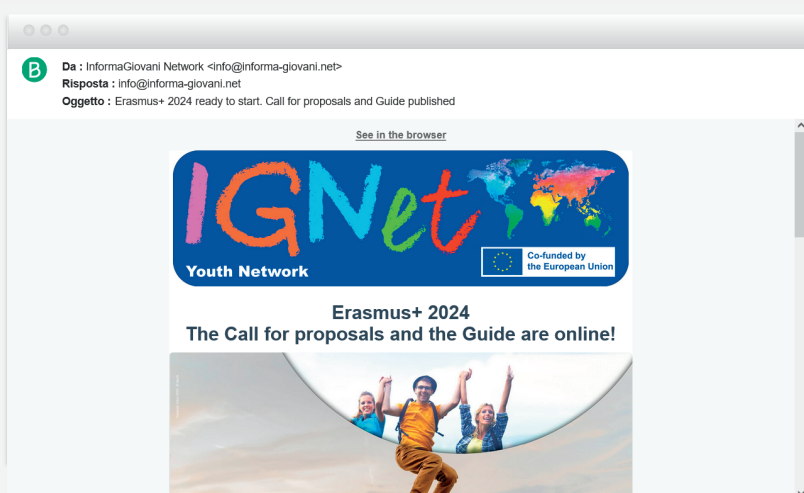

Erasmus+ 2024 The Call for proposals and the Guide are online!



The European Commission has published the call for proposals and the Operational Guide for 2024 under Erasmus+, the EU programme supporting education, training, youth and sport in Europe.

The 2024 edition of the Programme promises to be greener (increased budget and contribution for sustainable travel) and more inclusive (increased financial contribution for inflation adjustment).

With a budget of EUR 4.3 billion for next year, Erasmus+ will continue to support young people's transnational experiences in formal (schools, universities and vocational training) and non-formal settings.

The programme also offers opportunities for students and young adults, educators and staff of youth organisations and sports organisations.

In 2024, the programme will offer stronger incentives for sustainable travel. It will be presented from 2024 as a default option, with participants from remote areas, islands or places with insufficient rail networks receiving appropriate compensation for using such sustainable travel modes.

Activities can range from supporting small-scale projects at local level to transnational initiatives. These initiatives are playing a major role in the green and digital transitions of education and training systems.

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ call, any public or private body active in the fields of education, training, youth and sport can apply for funding through the [Erasmus+ National Agencies](#) or through the EACEA - [European Education and Culture Executive Agency](#).
